

TRAFFIC ALERTS & SPECIAL EVENTS

Construction Work on North Main Street – Starting Monday night, 9/27/10 Elk Pipeline Company will be installing a new gas main on North Main Street. They will begin at the intersection of Rt. 322 & North Main Street and proceed southbound, eventually ending on Route 322 at Hazelton Terrace. They will work Monday thru Thursday from 8:00 pm to 6:00 am. (Yes, they will be working at night.) It is anticipated that it will take 2 to 3 weeks to complete this phase of the project.

Installation of Traffic Signal at High Street and Route 45 – This work is also scheduled to start on Monday, 9/27/10. It will impact traffic on both High Street and Rt. 45 as well as parking on Main Street. This project is expected to take 5 or 6 days.

Milling & Repaving of Route 322 from Clems Run to WaWa – This work is scheduled to start on October 4th. We do not have any further details at this time.

An Important Note Regarding Snow Plowing – Not that we expect it to snow anytime soon, it is still important to share the following request from our Public Works Department: In an effort to make our plowing operation more efficient and reduce damage to property during storms, Public Works asks that **any resident who lives in a development without curbing to please mark their property at the edge of the pavement with some sort of visible marker that is at least 36 inches tall**. This will assist the snow plow drivers in determining where the edge of the road stops so the leading edge of the plow does not damage lawns, sprinkler systems, etc. In this type of development it is difficult for the drivers to see the edge of the road after several inches of snow has fallen. This precautionary measure will eliminate costly repairs to property.
